ROOF ON COLD COLD STORAGE BLDG: Councilman Beechler said he has gotten quotes for the replacement of the roof on the Cold Storage Building. He said the lowest bid was from Kevin Horning. Supervisor Teed asked for a resolution.

Councilman King offered the following Resolution. RESOLVED that the replacement of the Cold Storage Roof be awarded to Kevin Horning for an amount \$13,700, which is the lowest bid. The Resolution was seconded by Councilman Beechler, who moved its adoption. 5 AYES. Carried.

UPDATE ON WATER PROJECTS BY MRB ENGINEER, PAT NICOLETTA: Supervisor Teed asked our Engineer, Pat Nicoletta from MRB if he had any updates on the various water projects. Mr. Nicoletta said the all the numbers will be in by the end of the month and we expect to start construction of the Pelis Road Water District in April or May, depending on the weather, with completion by early summer.

Mr. Nicoletta said the Orleans Water District, Extension #1 is in the Comptroller's hands and we hope to hear word on that within the next 2-3 weeks. He said after we hear from the Comptroller the design will begin on this district.

Mr. Nicoletta said we are just waiting for the Contractor and the weather to begin Melvin Hill Road Water District Extension and Repair. He said they are hoping to start in April or May with the completion by June.

SUPERINTENDENT FEATHERLY: Superintendent Featherly said he would like to have Sheriff Phil Povero reprint the article he had in the paper at the beginning of winter regarding the passing of snow plows.
